

GROUP SALES:

Groups Attending a Film in Current Release During Regular Business Hours:

Groups of 15 – 49 people wanting to attend a regularly scheduled showing of a current film in release.

Groups must contact the theater's General Manager at least one day in advance to make arrangements for this discount. (Please note that your group will be sharing the auditorium with the general public.)

Price: \$5.50* per person

Tickets/Payment: Advance tickets can be purchased at the box office of the theatre where you are attending the film.

Tickets can be purchased up to one week in advance at the theater box office. Cash, credit card, or company check may be accepted for this package.

Groups of 50 people or more who want to attend a regularly scheduled showing of a current film in release.

Groups of this size must make arrangements through Southside Works Cinema's home office Event Coordinator at least 7 days in advance. (Please note that your group will be sharing the auditorium with the general public.)

Price: \$5.50* per person with the option of one of our two concession specials. (See details below.)

Tickets/Payment: Payment is due 7 days prior to the event date at the theater or the home office. Cash, credit card, or company check can be accepted for this package.

Groups of any size interested in renting/buying out an entire auditorium during regular business hours of a regularly scheduled film for a private showing.

Groups must make arrangements through the Southside Works Cinema's home office Event Coordinator at least 7 days in advance.

Price: \$5.50* per seat multiplied by the total number of seats in the assigned auditorium. (Please note that films are frequently required by the film's distributor to be shown in a specific size auditorium. This means that we cannot always move the film to a smaller auditorium to reduce the cost of this package.) This package includes an option of one of our two concession specials. (See details below.)

Tickets/Payment: Payment is due 7 days prior to the event date at the theater or the home office. Cash, credit card, or company check may be accepted for this package. An Event Agreement Letter must be completed and submitted with payment.

Groups Attending a Film in Current Release Outside of Regular Business Hours:

A group of any size can arrange for a private screening outside of regular business hours for a current film in release.

Price: There is a minimum fee of \$440 for us to accommodate a group outside of regular business hours. This price is based on a group of at least 80 people at the group rate of \$5.50/per ticket. If your group is over 80 people, the fee will be \$5.50 per person.* This package includes an option of one of our two concession specials. (See details below.)

Tickets/Payment: Payment is due 7 days prior to the event date at the theater or the home office. Cash, credit card, or company check may be accepted for this package. An Event Agreement Letter must be completed and submitted with payment.

Bulk Discount Ticket Programs:

The following bulk discount ticket programs are perfect for corporate or personal gifts and incentives. Our Admit Ones allow you to buy a bulk supply of tickets that may be exchanged at the theater box office for admission to films playing at our cinemas.

Restricted Admit One Bulk Tickets: Restricted Admit Ones are sold in books of 50 tickets for \$337.50 (\$6.50 per ticket). Restricted Admit Ones are valid at the Southside Works Cinema. The Restricted Admit Ones are not valid for a film's first 10 days (or first two weekends) of release or the first 14 days of release for SONY Pictures films.

VIP Admit One Bulk Tickets: VIP Admit Ones are sold in books of 50 tickets for \$412.50 (\$8.25 per ticket). VIP Admit Ones are valid at the Southside Works Cinema. The VIP Admit Ones are valid for any regularly scheduled film at any time.

Please note if VIP or Restricted Admit Ones are redeemed for 3D films, an additional surcharge will be collected at the box office.

THEATER RENTALS:

Our theater is available for nearly any type of event whether it's a private screening, business meeting, or even a wedding. No matter what your plans, we'd love to help you have an amazing event.

The base fee to rent one of our auditoriums, regardless of seat count, for roughly a 2 and a half hour period is \$750. This base rate is not valid for Friday, Saturday and Monday events. Friday, Saturday and Monday events must be negotiated individually based on the specific event details and needs and theater availability.

Use of lobby space for receptions in conjunction with an auditorium rental or group sale is subject to an Event Fee of \$200 to \$400 (price negotiated based on the size of group and potential disruption of regular theater operations). This is based on a 4 hour period (including set-up and tear-down). \$100 will be charged for each additional hour.

Use of lobby space not used in conjunction with an auditorium rental or group sale are subject to a minimum fee of \$750. This is based on a 4 hour period (including set-up and tear-down). \$100 will be charged for each additional hour.

A 25% deposit and a signed rental agreement are required to hold any date for a rental event. Total payment is due 7 days prior to the event. Payment may be in the form of cash, business check, MasterCard, Discover or VISA.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Can I show any movie I want for my private screening?

A. As long as the film is available to us, we are able to show it. Please note that bringing in a classic or recently released film will incur additional costs for your event that include but aren't limited to film rental and shipping. The expense of renting and shipping a 35mm film print can cost between \$400 and \$600. The public performance rights for a DVD can cost between \$150 and \$300. (Please note that these are rough guidelines and can vary based on the specific film.)

Q. What film formats can Southside Works Cinema accommodate?

A. We can show 35mm film as well as digitally projected DVD's and Blu-Ray discs for no additional fee. If your film is on HDCAM, Beta SP, DigiBeta, MiniDV or other digital video formats, you will have to rent the necessary deck from a third party. Southside Works Cinema has established relationships with select A/V vendors and may be able to help secure a discounted rate on your behalf for this equipment.

Q. Does Southside Works Cinema offer a non-profit discount?

A. Yes. If your organization is a qualifying non-profit group, you may be eligible for a special non-profit rate.

Q. I would like to book a film that I have made to play at your theater. Who should I contact?

A. The rental rates quoted above are for single show rentals. If you are filmmaker looking for an extended theatrical run, please contact the Southside Works Cinema home office (440-349-3306) and you will be directed to the appropriate booking agent.

Q. Can I use one of your theaters for a Power Point presentation?

A. A laptop can be connected to one of our digital projectors to accommodate presentations. The client is responsible for supplying the laptop and any necessary remote control equipment.

Q. Does Southside Works Cinema have a microphone that we can use?

A. Yes. There is no additional fee to use our microphone.

Q. Do you provide catering services?

A. We do not. We do offer several concession discount packages for our rentals and groups. (See info below.) If your group brings in outside food for you event you may be subject to a cleaning fee of \$2.00 per person.

Q. What is included in my rental fee?

A. Your rental fee covers the following: Use of agreed upon auditorium and/or lobby space, Projection equipment and staff to operate it, Floor staff to ensure the smooth operation of your event.

Q. If I need to sell tickets to my event, can I use the Southside Works Cinema box office?

A. Yes, for an additional fee we will be happy to assist you with ticket sales. The fee is 3% of ticket sales or \$25 whichever is greater.

Q. Will any additional insurance be required?

A. Depending on the type of event or rental, you may be required to obtain additional insurance prior to your event.

Q. Will I be able to do a tech run through of my film before my rental?

A. A tech run can be arranged but may incur additional fees depending on your specific needs and requests.

Q. Will my screening/event be marketed by Southside Works Cinemas?

A. There is an additional charge for marketing support which must be arranged with the Director of Marketing.

Q. Am I able to show a combination of formats for my event (i.e. film and video)?

A. Yes. Additional fees may be assessed based on your specific needs and requests.

Q. Does the theater provide any tables, chairs or linens?

A. All rates include the use of two 6 foot tables with black tablecloths and 2 chairs. Any additional tables, chairs or linens are the responsibility of the renter to secure.

Q. Will the theatre be open to the public during my event?

A. Yes, unless other arrangements have been made which will incur additional charges.

CONCESSION PACKAGES

Concession Package #1: Each group member will receive one small fountain drink and one small popcorn for \$4.50 when purchased together. This special will be redeemed with coupons provided by Southside Works Cinema or special arrangements prior to the event.

Concession Package #2: Each group member will receive our Kid's Meal (child size drink, child portion of popcorn, and candy treat all in a convenient carry tray) for \$2.50 each. This special will be redeemed with coupons provided by Southside Works Cinema or special arrangements prior to the event.
